INTRODUCTION

Situation

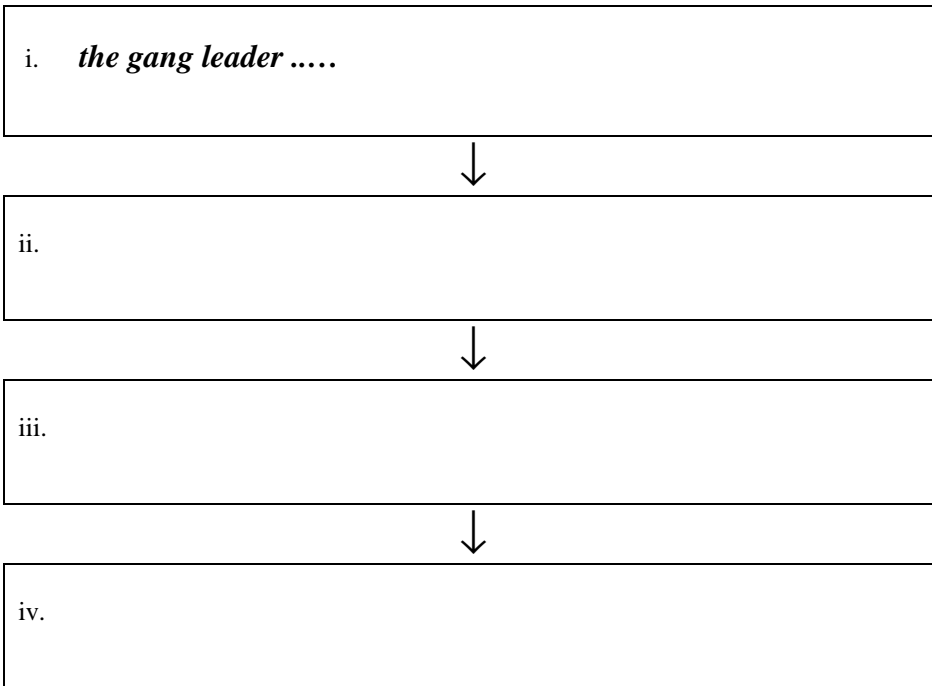

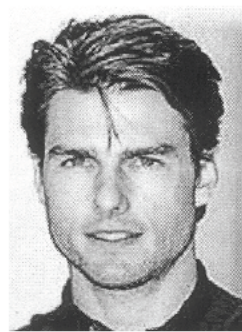

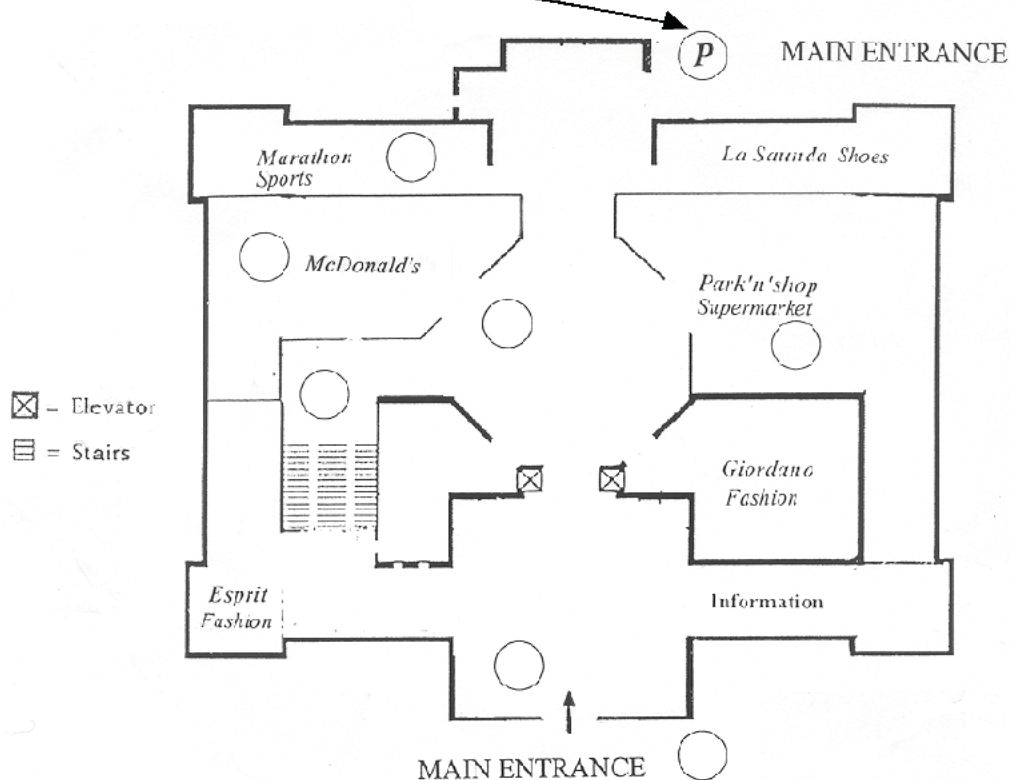
